KEY VOCABULARY

Painting	He process or art of using paint, in a picture, as a protective coating, or as decoration.
materials	Items which things can be made from.
Earth art	Sometimes known as land art. Is an art movement which emerged between 1960-70s. It uses natural materials and creating patterns or scenes.
Natural materials	any product or physical matter that comes from plants, animals, or the Earth.
Pictographs	Pictures to represent words or a phrase (Eg cave writing)
